DIRECTIONS: Blockade is easy to apply using a brush, medium nap roller, or low pressure sprayer. The surface to be treated does not need any special treatment but it must be dry and water, oil, and dust free to allow proper penetration of the product. Allow the sealer to impregnate the surface for 5-10 minutes and then remove the excess from the surface (this is the most important step because if the sealer dries on the surface it will leave a residue). Allow to dry for 2 hours. Re-apply using the same procedure and then remove the excess. The polymer will cure in approx 24 hours at 60 deg F. After curing, place a small droplet of water on the surface to check that it beads up and this will indicate that the sealer has satisfactorily cured.

Pre-Cleaning Recommendations (if needed): Any of Share's water soluble cleaners or degreasers.

Coverage: Blockade will cover approximately 250 to 500 square feet per gallon depending on the concrete porosity and two coats are recommended. Typically a 5 gallon pail will seal 1,000 square feet of poured concrete using two applications.

Life Expectancy: 2-3 years under normal conditions.
