FOR DRAIN MAINTENANCE: Most drain insect infestations result from the accumulation of food materials on the inside of drain surfaces. This is where fly, mosquito, and insect larvae are laid as insects go to feed. Regular use of DYNASTY CLEAR OUT establishes an active bacterial population that continuously works to keep organic matter from building up, thus eliminating feeding and breeding sites for insects. Add 1 ounce of DYNASTY CLEAR OUT to drains once a week. Allow the product to work overnight before using drains to give bacteria time to work. For drains that receive large amounts of organic matter (kitchens and garbage disposals), increase the dosage to 2 or 3 ounces once per week.

TO REMOVE DRAIN BLOCKAGES: Pour 2 ounces of DYNASTY CLEAR OUT into clogged drain. Its thickened formula will carry this unique product directly to the site of the stoppage. Allow drain to set undisturbed for at least 6 hours-preferably overnight. Flush drain with hot water for several minutes to loosen clog and restore normal drain flow. If flow is not completely restored, repeat.
